

Tish Anne Kilgore is a pianist and flutist. She is the Director of Center Stage in Westford, where classes and performing opportunities are offered in music, dance and theater. She taught piano, flute and voice at her home studio in Groton for 20 years, music classes at the Groton Community School, Parker School, and Country Day School, and was Director of Music at the First Parish Church of Groton. She studied flute with John Oberbrunner and voice with Ruth Pinnell. Ms. Kilgore has a BA in piano performance from Syracuse University's School for the Arts, an M. She has spent the last 20 years writing everything BUT her dissertation (which is on selected piano works of Franz Liszt); 20 musical theater pieces for youth, essays, articles, poetry, letters, e-mails...
